10.5 - 11	The student shows full and deep knowledge in all components of thematic questions, reasons logically, independently extrapolates thematic questions with adjacent education courses and/or clinical correlates.
9.5 - 10	The student shows full and deep knowledge in almost all components of thematic questions, reasons logically, makes insignificant mistakes in the process of extrapolating thematic questions with adjacent education courses and/or clinical correlates.
8.5 - 9	The student shows fairly good knowledge of thematic questions, reasons independently and thinks analytically.
7.5 - 8	The student shows above-average knowledge of thematic questions, reasons logically and independently.
6.5 - 7	The student shows average knowledge of thematic questions, makes insignificant mistakes in the process of independent reasoning.
5.5 - 6	The student shows below-average knowledge of thematic questions, is limited in independent reasoning around thematic questions, makes logical inaccuracies, but independently corrects them with right instructions.
4.5 - 5	The student shows limited knowledge of thematic questions, makes logical inaccuracies in the process of independent reasoning, hardly corrects them with right instructions.
3.5 - 4	The student shows limited knowledge of thematic questions, makes logical inaccuracies in the process of independent reasoning, hardly corrects them with right and detailed instructions.
2.5 - 3	The student shows very limited knowledge of thematic questions, although deals perfectly with definitions and concepts (grading – according to number and complexity of the questions).
1.5 - 2	The student shows very limited knowledge of thematic questions, deals imperfectly with definitions and concepts (grading – according to number and complexity of the questions).
0.5 - 1	The student shows critically limited knowledge of thematic questions, is limited to definitions and concepts (grading – according to number and complexity of the questions).
0	The student shows no knowledge of facts.
