GEORGIAN LANGUAGE 1 / I semester Physical therapy and rehabilitation
Reading and writing: Georgian alphabet. Vowel system ა, ე, ი, ო, უ, მ and consonants

Grammar: Personal Pronouns (singular forms), verb “to be” conjugation in present simple tense. Postpositions -αὐτῶν, -αὐτοῦ;
Topic: “Acquaintance” (What’s your name? Where are you from? What do you do?; Grammar – the verb “to be” (conjugation in present tense), personal pronouns;
Greetings and Farewell. Dialogues
Possessive pronouns (My, your...), Interrogative pronouns: who? What? How many/much? how? From where? Where? What kind?, etc.
Numerals – Cardinal numbers 1-20; Telling and asking a person’s age
Topic - “About myself”, “My best Friend”
Verb “to have” for both living and nonliving objects
Topic – “my family”. Adjectives and useful expressions.
Topic – Time; Units of time (second, minute ... century), weekdays, seasons, prepositions – on, in; When is your birthday?; vocabulary, adjectives (early-late, etc)
Topic – Time; phrases for future and past (today, yesterday, tomorrow). Conjugation of ver “to be” in the past simple and future tenses.
Topic - “My day”; Verbs: to wake up, to eat, to go, to study, to go to sleep;
