Thematic plan

1. Anaesthesia in pediatric dental clinics. The features of performance of local anaesthesia in children of different age.
2. Tooth extraction. Indications for primary (milk) and permanent tooth extraction. Primary tooth extraction features. General and local complications during and after tooth extraction surgery and their prevention.
3. Tooth, jaw bones and facial soft tissue traumatic injuries in children and adolescents. Injuries of tooth hard tissue: bruises, congested, complete and incomplete dislocated (drop out) tooth, teeth fracture, diagnosis and treatment.
4. Facial soft tissue traumatic injuries: bruises, wounds, burns, frostbites. Treatment principles.
Jaw bone traumatic injuries: bruises, fractures. Fracture features in children and adults. Diagnostics and treatment.
5. Oral mucosal malformations. Tongue-tie, ankyloglossia. Its plastics. Upper and lower lip's frenum malformation. Frenum correction. Narrow oral vestibulum. Its plastics. Optimal dates of surgical treatment.
