## Evaluation System in Immunology

The components of the assessment are the intermediate assessment and the final exam assessment, the sum of which is the final assessment.
Final evaluation score is as follows:
There are five positive evaluations:
a) (A) excellent -91-100\%
b) (B) very good $-81-91 \%$
c) (C) $\operatorname{good}-71-80 \%$
d) (D) satisfactory $-61-70 \%$
e) (E) least satisfactory $-51-60 \%$
and two negative evaluations:
a) (Fx) not passed - 41-50\%
b) (F) failed $-0-40 \%$

If total sum of all components ranges from 41 to $50 \%$, student is granted another chance to pass the exam. If total sum of all components is less than $41 \%$, the student is denied to pass exam until the same course is attended again. The final exam is repeatedly scheduled only once.

Students are admitted to the final exam if their accumulative intermediate assessment and the possible minimum exam score in total is equal to, or greater than, 51 points

Intermediate assessment is the sum of points obtained according to the knowledge assessment methods / parts provided in the syllabus of the training course and is determined by 60 points. The intermediate assessment (maximum 60 points) includes the following methods / parts:

1. 1a. Class activity $-\mathbf{4 0}$ scores.
2. Class activity is assessed using short daily tests during the seminars. Test comprises 16 MCQ or True/False questions. Each correct answer is evaluated by 0.5 scores.

Overall class activity during semester is sum of 5 daily tests' scores.

## 1b. Midterm quiz - 20 scores

Quiz includes General Immunology issues. Student is required to demonstrate knowledge of issues that are discussed at lectures and seminars. Quiz contains 20 MCQ tests. Every correct answer is evaluated by 1 score.
2. Final exam - $\mathbf{4 0}$ scores

The Student is required to demonstrate knowledge of material presented at lectures and seminars. The examination is written.

The exam is held in the Examination Center. Knowledge of the whole course of Immunology is required. Each variant of ticket contains 100 MCQ tests. Every correct answer is evaluated by 0.4 score.

The exam for students of other faculties is held in the department. Knowledge of the whole course of Immunology is required. Each variant of ticket contains 40 MCQ tests. Every correct answer is evaluated by 1 score.
Exam is passed if
1.Final assessment score is not less than 51,
2.Student receives positive evaluation in exam: 24 or more out of 40 scores.
