

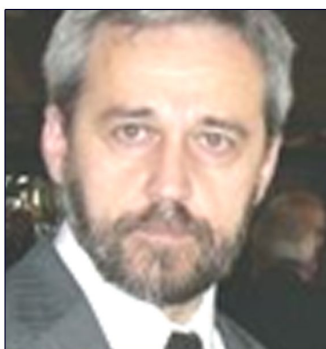

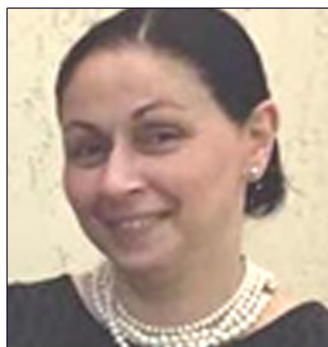

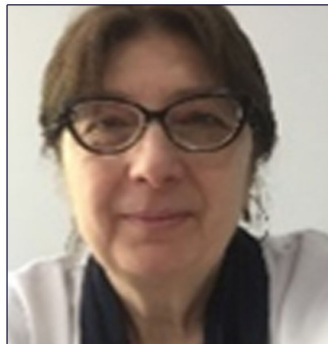

## DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND CLINICAL PHARMACY



The organization and history of pharmaceutical work has been taught since 1926 at the Department of Pharmacy and Pharmacognosy of the Faculty of Medicine of Tbilisi University (Chairman - Master of Pharmacy Eduard Abol).

In 1935-1949, at the Department of Medicines and Galenic Preparations Technology (Associate Professor Irakli Burjanadze). In 1949-1972, at the Department of Pharmaceutical Technology (Chairman Professor Petre Gelbakhian).

In 1972-1990, the subject was taught at the Department of Drug Technology, headed by Professor Levan Chkhararashvili. With his great efforts and the support of the rector, in 1990, the chair of drug technology was divided into two and a separate chair of pharmaceutical business organization and economy was established, which was headed by Mr. Levan Chkhatarashvili himself until the end of his life (1992). In 1992-1997, the chair was headed by Professor Guram Tsagareishvili. During the next ten years, 1997-2017 The department was headed by full professor Vazha Eriashvili. During this period, the department changed its name three times: in 2001, it was called the Department of Social Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Work Organization, then in 2003 - the Department of Social and Clinical Pharmacy, and in 2006 - the Department of Social and Clinical Pharmacy. In 2017-2020, the department was headed by Professor Tamaz Chumburidze.

From 2020 to the present, the head of the department is Professor Nana Gorgaslidze, [worked at the department in 1980-90 as an assistant; 1997-2006 - in the position of docent; 2013-2020 - associate professor].

The following professors and senior teachers worked at the department at different times: G. Chikhladze, P. Geliashvili, R. Skhiladze, B. Bochorishvili, J. E nukidze, I. Murgulia, G. It's right. ## DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND CLINICAL PHARMACY

The main scientific directions of the department are: principles of pharmaceutical establishment and activity management; aspects of pharmacist-patient relationship; "Pharmacoeconomic and marketing research of medicinal products," "Pharmaceutical activity management". The main disciplines are taught in the department: organization and economy of pharmaceutical activity; Pharmaceutical care, clinical pharmacy, pharmaceutical ethics and deontology. Communication skills. Optional disciplines: pharmaceutical product merchandising, pharmaceutical management and marketing. Pharmaceutical Information and Communication. Master's programs "Pharmacy Management" and "Clinical Pharmacy" operate on the basis of the department.

Today, there is one professor in the department - the head of the department, Professor Nana Gorgaslidze. Two associate professors - Tamaz Chumburidze and Natia Kvizhinadze, four assistant professors - Nestan (Neli) Nikuradze, Nino (Ninuka) Nemsitsveridze, Thea Zarqua Nana Tughashvili, one guest teacher - Nana Yamanidze, and one laboratory assistant - Ioseb (Soso) Tomadze.
