Department of Therapeutic and Preventive Stomatology of Child Age was established in 1979 as a course. In 1991, the course was rendered in the cathedra. From 1979 to 2006, the cathedra encompassed 3 directions: Pediatric Surgical Stomatology (Maxillofacial Surgery) and Orthodontia.

Since 2006 the cathedra was named as the Department of Child and Adult Preventive and Therapeutic Stomatology. The latter unites 2 directions: Therapeutic Stomatology and Surgical Stomatology. From 2017 department changed into direction and by now it unites two departments: Department of Child and Adolescent Therapeutic Stomtology lead by professor Tamar ShishniaShvili and

Department of Child and Adolescent Maxillo-facial Surgery and Surgical Stomatology lead by professor Zurab Vadachkoria.
