THE DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL NEUROLOGY



The undergraduate educational program of the Department of Clinical Neurology is developed for the medicine, dentistry and physical medicine and rehabilitation students. The postgraduate educational programs of the department cover residency, PHD and problem-based short courses.

Areas of clinical and scientific interests in the department include ischemic strokes, dementia, epilepsy, movement disorders, multiple sclerosis, and primary headaches. The department is actively involved in the studies of clinical trials of multiple sclerosis, migraine and chronic pain. In collaboration with the Netherlands partners, an epilepsy and sleep learning center was established at the department.

In 2013-2015 within the framework of scholarship of the Shota Rustaveli National Science Foundation of Georgia, the department studied mild cognitive impairment (MCI) in Georgia and published a guideline about the issue. The academic staff of the department published books in Georgian language, "Clinical Neurology" (Professor Marine Janelidze 2009, 2013).
