The Thematic Plan for the Lecture Course

The Bachelor's Program of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Basics of Diagnostics (IV Semester)

- Introduction to Diagnostics of Internal Medicine; Definitions; Means and significance; Ethical issues.
- Components of medical history: subjective, objective physical, laboratory and instrumental methods of investigation.
- Symptoms of respiratory failure and methods of investigation respiratory system;
- Main syndromes in cardiovascular diseases and methods of investigation;
- Symptomatology of Gastrointestinal tract disorders and methods of investigation;
- Symptoms and syndromes of liver and biliary tract diseases and methods of investigation;
- Symptomatology of kidney and urinary tract disorders and methods of investigation;
- Disorders flowing with edema and water and electrolyte imbalance and methods of investigation;
- Symptomatology of endocrine system disorders and methods of investigation;
- Symptomatology of blood and hemopoesis system disorders and methods if investigation.
