**Internal Disease (V Semester)**

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease; Chronic bronchitis; Emphysema;
- Bronchial asthma;
- Acute bronchitis; Pneumonia; Lung cancer;
- Pleural diseases: Exudate and Adhesive pleuritis; pneumothorax;
- Atherosclerosis and cardio-metabolic risk factors: Hypertension, Dyslipidemia; Diabetes Mellitus;
- Ischemic heart disease: Angina; Myocardium Infarction;
- Rheumatic fever; Rheumocarditis; Endocarditis; Acquired valvular diseases;
