From 1941 new name is "Health Care organization Department" and head of Departments Professors Alexander Khmaladze, Anteoz Asatiani. In 1958 Professor Anteoz Asatiani Published new and first text-book in Georgian Language. The Georgian textbooks edited and published by him are widely used by students and professionals even today.

From 1966 Department of "Social Hygiene and Health Care Organization"-Heads of Department - Professors Anteoz Asatiani, Valerian Cabadze, Associated Professor Jacob Babucidze. Scientific Research Of Professor Valerian Cabadze. About Development of Health Condition of Georgian Population is the first Scientific report about Health Condition in Georgia. Professor Valerian Cabadze Author of lot of Practical and Theoretical textbooks.

From 1992 Department of Public Health and Health Care Management. Head of Department from 1989-to 2009 Professor Otar Gerzmava. Department edited and published new textbooks In Georgian language in 1990, 1998, 2001, 2003, 2008,

2012,2013,2016, 2017, author Professor Gerzmava, and co-authors academic staff of Department.

Since 2009 the head of the department of Department of Public Health, Health Care Management, Policy and Economy has been Professor Levan Baramidze. The department won 8 scholarships to carry out academic research, including a grant from non profit organisation "Open Society Georgia Foundation".
