THE DEPARTMENT OF PROPAEDEUTIC OF INTERNAL DISEASES



The Department of Propaedeutic of Internal Diseases was established within the framework of the Department of Medicine in 1919. The department was headed by Professor Alexander Aladashvili. The same year, the Department of Pathology and Therapy of Internal Medicine was founded, directed by Prof. Spiridon Virsaladze. In 1935 the departments were united and the Department of Propaedeutic of Internal Diseases was finally established.

The Department of Propaedeutic of Internal Diseases was directed by various professors.

More than 800 scientific works have been developed by the academic staff of the department. Four books were published and one book was translated from English into Georgian language. Many famous scientists and scholars worked at the department. They initiated the foundation of diverse scientific and research institutes in Georgia.
