

Assessment of Academic Achievement for Bachelor's Programs

I. Activity - 30 Points

- Full completion of the planned laboratory work for each of the 10 practicals - **3 points** per practical.

The 3-point grading system for knowledge evaluation is as follows:

- **3 points:** The student has a deep understanding of the topic, provides comprehensive answers to additional questions, and uses correct terminology.
- **2 points:** The answer is complete but inconsistent. The discussion shows that the student mostly understands the topic but makes inaccuracies.
- **1 point:** The quality of the answer and discussion is satisfactory, but the student makes significant errors.
- **0 points:** The answer to the question is completely unsatisfactory.

II. Testing - 10 Points

- Quizzes for each of the 10 practicals, consisting of a 5-question test. Each correct answer is **0.2 points** ($5 \times 0.2 = 1$ point).
- $1 \times 10 = 10$ points.

III. Colloquiums - 20 Points

- There will be 2 colloquiums. Each test will have 25 questions. Each correct answer is **0.4 points** ($25 \times 0.4 = 10$ points).
- $2 \times 10 = 20$ points.

A student will be admitted to the final exam if the sum of their semester assessments is a minimum of **27 points**.
