Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – Credit mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of studies and research at University of Sassari for Residents from the Tbilisi State Medical University.

Selected students will be awarded a scholarship, will attend courses and will use all the facilities of The University of Sassari on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

The Erasmus+ Programme is an initiative launched by the European Commission to fund mobilities among EU countries and between Programme Countries (EU countries) and Partner Countries (countries from the rest of the world).

The Programme also enhances the opportunities for cooperation and mobility with Partner Countries in the fields of higher education.

Mobility students will receive a grant as a contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the period of study and an amount to support them in covering their travel costs.

Mobility students can attend courses and use all the facilities available at the University of Sassari with no additional tuition fees. All learning activities approved in the Learning Agreement and completed successfully will be fully recognized at the home university.

The Home Universities will be in charge of selecting students and sending them to the University of Sassari (including preparation, monitoring and recognition related to the mobility period) and of announcing this call through their own web page and other publicity means.

Mobility periods Master's level.

Duration: 5 months- one semester.

Grant amount: 850 € per month; Travel grants 360 €.

Conditions and procedures General conditions for admittance the candidate student must be enrolled at the TSMU that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with the University of Sassari.

The student must be preselected and nominated by the TSMU

Language requirements and language support

Main language of instruction is Italian. For mobility students will be held in English.

The University of Sassari organizes free Italian language courses addressed to incoming students throughout the academic year.

Furthermore, intensive courses are organized in September and in February, just before the beginning of each semester. Intensive courses allow incoming students to acquire or strengthen a basic level of Italian. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive in time to attend the intensive language courses. Insurance
