1	Language skills – IELTS 6.5 overall, with at least 6 in each skill	Provide evidence of a certified Home Office approved English language test, i.e. UKIELTS. The required IELTS score is: Postgraduate: 6.5 overall with no less than 5.5 in each band	40%
		If you are not able to take this test but feel you have a good command of English language, you can still apply and <i>if accepted</i> , you may beable to sit a University of Chester English Language Test (UoCELT) conducted via Skype.	
2	Letter of motivation	This should include information about why you have chosen the particular modules, what you hope to achieve from the mobility and how this will contribute to your own professional development.	30%
3	Academic achievements	Provide details and evidence of all your academic qualifications.	30%
