**SELECTION PURPOSE** 

The aim of the selection is to select candidates for teaching mobility realised at the receiving

funding (the receiving institution and its National Agency's financial agreement).

The priority areas for teaching is Biomedical Engineering according to the TSMU

strategy strategy or internationalization.

An Erasmus+ teaching flow consists in carrying out teaching activities (minimum 8 hours in 5

working days) agreed upon with the receiving institution in advance.

A teaching flow lasts minimum 5 working days (travel days excluded).

**ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES** 

Academic teachers employed at TSMU – existing employment agreement.

Submitting the application is treated as the declaration of English language proficiency at the

level stipulated by the receiving institution in the Inter-Institutional Agreement.

**SELECTION SCHEDULE** 

Erasmus + Institutional Coordinator of TSMU appoints the Selection Commission.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The submitted applications and individual teaching programmes are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The submitted applications and individual teaching programmes are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- **Teaching experience/Seniority** according to international mobility for teaching purposes; (max 10 points)
- Offering courses in English for incoming students; (max 20 points)
- Sustainability: Proposed teaching activities will be carried out in the framework of International joint programme (preparations are already done and agreed with the faculty of Host Institution) (max 20 points);
- Compliance with the priority areas of your university's / home faculty development / internationalization strategy (e.g. introducing a new Erasmus Plus programme, strengthening international cooperation in particular area, etc.) (max 40 points)
- **Previous participance** (max 10 pioints)

#### SELECTION RESULTS

The result of the selection proceedings is a ranking list of selected candidates.

The candidate with the higher number of points tops the list. Individual grants are awarded according to the order of candidates.

Candidates not covered by the receiving institution and its National Agency's financial agreement constitute a reserve list with the option of "zero-grant" mobility.

The selection results are announced by sending an individual message to the e-mail address indicated in the internal application form.

#### APPEAL PROCEDURE

A candidate has the right to appeal from the decision of the Selection Commission within 7 days from announcement of selection results. The appeal is to be sent to **International Affairs Department of TSMU.**
